The first cars were known as 'Horseless carriages'. They took to the roads in the 1880s. It was the petrol engine that made possible the age of the motor car. In 1770 Nicolas Cugnot, a French inventor, built a steam tractor. It was the world's first powered vehicle, but it was very slow. Although other steam cars were built, steam engines were not really suitable for road transport. During the 1860 the problems of making a good petrol engine were solved. In 1886 Gottlieb Daimler of Germany made the first car fitted with a petrol engine. By 1893 cars such as the Benz Velo were being built and sold in Europe and America. Henry Ford built his first car in 1896 and went on to start the world's first car factory to make cars quickly and cheaply.
